1. Declarations of Interest

2. Minutes

The accuracy of the Minutes of the previous meetings of the Committee held on 2 April 2015 was agreed and the Minutes signed in accordance with paragraph 7(1) of Schedule 7 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973.

4. Education and Youth Employment - Early Retirements
