1. Executive Summary

1.1 This report provides details of the results of the Elections to North Ayrshire Council held on Thursday 5 May 2022 and on the signing of the Declaration of Acceptance of Office by all Elected Members.

2. Background

- 2.1 The Elections to the nine wards within the North Ayrshire Council area were held on Thursday 5 May 2022 with the electronic verification and counting of votes (eCount) taking place on Friday 6 May 2022 at The Portal, High Street, Irvine.
- 2.2 The overall turnout was 44% of the electorate. The total number of ballots received was 48,121. Of these, 47,003 (43%) were considered valid and 1,118 (1%) were rejected.
