Ward 05 - Saltcoats and Stevenston

I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 05 - Saltcoats and Stevenston. There are 5 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 16,951 and the number of ballot papers received was 6,708 giving a percentage turnout of $39.6 \%$. There were 202 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,085 .
